PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

When playing football, I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of my team.
- Play fairly, I will not cheat, dive, complain or waste time.
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee and my coach and manager.
- Play by the rules
- Be gracious in victory and defeat – I will shake hands with the other team and referee before and at the end of the game.
- Listen, respond and respect what my coach and manager tells me.
- Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the team and not the individual player.
- I will not use violence in any form, whether it is against other players, spectators or team officials.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Never ridicule another child for making a mistake.
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

I understand that if I do not follow the code the following actions may be taken by my club, the County FA or the FA:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, the referee, or the team manager.
- Receive a formal warning from the coach, manager or club committee.
- Be dropped or substituted.
- Be suspended from training.
- Be required to leave the club.
- Have to pay a fine to the County FA.
